Our community volunteers, audiences, funders and sponsors have been simply fantastic during these difficult times, and we thank everyone for their support and encouragement as we resume our indoor programme of live performances this winter.

We want to let you know that your comfort and safety continue to be our top priority, as well as your enjoyment of course. Below you will find a little more information about our indoor events and venues, which we will monitor and update throughout the season as required:

- Audience members are reminded not to attend if you are experiencing symptoms of, or have tested positive for, Covid-19. Contact Artsreach to discuss ticket exchanges/refunds.
- Although not mandatory, we encourage our audiences and volunteers to continue to wear masks, particularly when moving around the venue
- Hand sanitiser will be available at various points within the venue
- Audiences will be no more than 70% of the venue capacity advanced booking is strongly encouraged
- Venues are encouraged to have good ventilation during their events; dress appropriately
- Please be conscious of social distancing during your visit
- Performers and audience members may like to take a lateral flow test before attending events.
- Venues may have an NHS Test & Trace QR code on display, enabling you to scan in if you wish
