We are delighted to welcome Artsreach audiences back as we re-launch with an outdoor programme of events this summer.

This performance runs without an interval, but is a relaxed performance, so you are free to leave your seat at any time during the show to visit the toilet.

You'll be seated on the grass, so please bring your own chairs, rugs, blankets and cushions to sit on. Remember to dress for all weather and bring a torch just in case – no umbrellas please. Assistance dogs only please.

At present, this event is being sold in accordance with current social distancing guidelines. Should government guidance on social distancing change prior to the performance date, we reserve the right to release additional tickets. All ticket holders will be informed should this take place and if you no longer wish to attend because social distancing does not apply, you will be entitled to a refund on request.

As the government's roadmap for the easing of restrictions is dependent on a number of factors, we are introducing measures across our entire season to ensure the safety of our audiences, performers and volunteers, until such time that restrictions are lifted:

What we are currently doing to make you and our volunteers feel safe . . .

- Restricting audience numbers
- Ensuring socially distanced seating
- Providing hand sanitiser/soap stations at the box office and toilets
- Using one-way systems where necessary to enable social distancing
- Offering face visors to our staff and volunteers in addition to masks

In return, please show you care by . . .

- not attending if you are experiencing symptoms of Covid-19 (fever, cough, loss of taste or smell)
- only booking tickets for your household / support bubble (maximum 6)
- providing names and contact numbers for everyone in your party, which can be passed to the Track and Trace service if necessary and/or scanning a venues QR code on arrival
- bringing a face mask and wearing as required until seated
- showing your ticket on a mobile device / verbally confirming your name / reference number
- respecting any social distancing measures in place
- supporting our volunteers by showing patience as required
