The Balvenie Aged 10yr, Speyside, 40.0% abv <i>Deep amber in colour. Retracked in Oloroso Sherry casks to give a Sherry like nose, with a nutty, malty finish. Very smooth and very popular with or without water.</i>	£4.70
Bowmore Aged 12yr, Islay, 40.0% abv <i>From the earliest distillery on Islay. Complex and more subtle than the more Southern Isles. Smoky, but not medicinal with underlying toffee notes. Sweet flavour with a dry finish.</i>	£4.70
Bunnahabhan Aged 12yr, Highland 40.0% abv <i>The nose offers a fresh and aromatic experience with a subtle whiff of smoke floating through the air. A light fruit and nut appeal that leads to a spectacular malty sweetness.</i>	£4.70
Dalwhinnie Aged 15yr, Highland 40.0% abv <i>The highest distillery in Scotland at Drumochter Pass. Pale straw with a little peat and malt on the nose. Medium-bodied, sweetish and slightly oily. A little heather honey on the finish.</i>	£4.70
Glenfiddich Aged 12yr, Highland 40.0% abv <i>A fragrant, complex malt which balances elegant notes of fresh pear and subtle oak.</i>	£4.70
Glenkinchie Aged 12yr, Lowland 43.0% abv <i>One of the last operating distilleries in Lowland Scotland. Soft and delicate aroma, with grassy and slightly sweet fruity notes. Smooth and malty with a touch of peat.</i>	£4.70
Glenmorangie Aged 10yr, Highland 40.0% abv <i>Top single malt in the UK. Pale with floral and citric notes. Medium bodied and complex yet easy to drink. Balanced with traces of almonds, spice and woodsmoke.</i>	£4.70
Glenlivet Aged 12yr, Speyside 40.0% abv <i>Exquisite delicacy of summer-like fragrances, with playful interlacing of floral and fruity aromas. Oak tenderly enhances that enticing bouquet with more vanilla and nutty notes.</i>	£4.70
Highland Park Aged 12 yr, Orkney, 40.0% abv <i>Mid-gold in colour with heathery, smoky undertones. Delicate balance of sweet and dry, and the signature smoky “catch” on the finish.</i>	£4.70.
Isle of Jura Aged 10yr, Jura – Maritime, 40.0% abv <i>Deep amber gold, light, rich and aromatic. Positive and firm, with silky, almondy wood notes. A firm and distinguished flavour with a fruity oiliness and just a hint of smoke gently</i>	£4.70
Lagavulin Aged 16yr, Islay, 43.0% abv <i>Limited in supply. Deep amber with a nose of Lapsong Souchong tea or scented smoke. Dry, toasted and exotic, the flavour begins sweet, malty and sherried but develops into a dry, smoky whisky with a lingering peat smoke and salt finish.</i>	£5.50
Laphroaig (La – froyg) Aged 10yr, Islay, 40.0% abv <i>Very pungent and a slightly salty tang. Peat-smoke, diesel oil and iodine are marked on the aromas and carried through to the palate. Often describe as the “salty sea dog” of the malts.</i>	£4.70
Macallan Aged 10yr, Speyside, 40.0% abv <i>A lighter, more accessible malt. Aged in American and European oak casks, helping to produce a smooth and elegant taste. A malty palate with balanced oak and fruit.</i>	£4.20
Old Pulteney Aged 12yr, Highland, 40.0% abv <i>Dry, medium bodied and smooth; faintly salty with a sherry note. Elegant touches of smoke and peat.</i>	£4.70
Talisker Aged 10yr, Skye – Maritime, 45.8% abv <i>Mid-gold with a pungent, burnt sticks aroma. Big bodied, creamy mouth feel, with a spicy, smoky and black pepper finish. Known as “the lava of the Cuillins”.</i>	£4.70
