Emergency parking provisions

To improve access for holders of our "Can't Wait Card", it is recognised that there will be occasions when members will need to park in a hurry to find and use toilet facilities and it may not always be possible to park legally. In these circumstances, Leeds City Council has agreed to cancel any Penalty charges that are issued. This applies to all parking restrictions **except**:

- Disabled bays
- No loading areas (indicated by kerb markings & yellow lines)
- Zig zags near schools and crossings

All other restrictions such as standard yellow lines and pay and display spaces are covered. The exemption applies for up to 15 minutes. It only applies in emergencies and tickets will not be cancelled if the vehicle is parked for longer or if the parking is for another purpose.

If a card holder receives a ticket they should write in with a photocopy of their "Cant Wait Card". The parking administration office will then cancel the ticket.

Please note that uniformed staff do not have the discretion to remove a ticket once issued, and appeals cannot be considered by "Crohn's and Colitis UK". All ticket appeals must be made to the administration office. They can be contacted on 0113 395 0050 or
