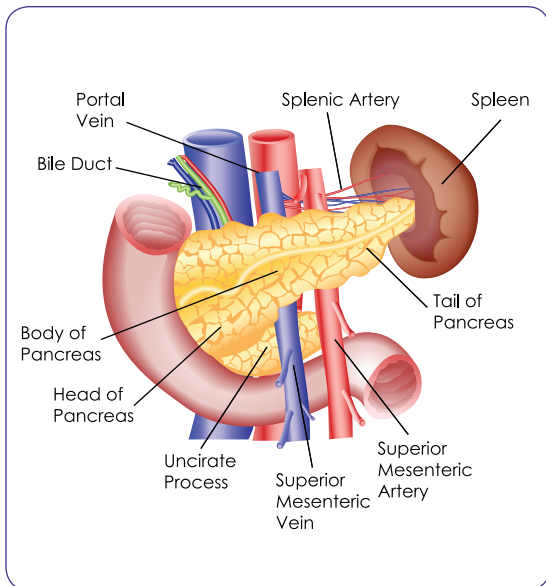
FROM EARLY DIAGNOSIS TO COMPLEX SURGERY

- Surgical resection remains the only potentially curative option and is associated with a 5-year overall survival rate
