

Gynae-oncology nurse led clinic

This sheet will give you some useful background information on the gynae-oncology nurse led clinic, so that you know what to expect. If you would like further information, or have any particular worries, please do not hesitate to ask your clinical nurse specialist (CNS), as detailed below. In all cases, your CNS will be happy to explain the process to you and answer any questions you may have.

What is the gynae-oncology nurse led clinic?

Following completion of your treatment at the University College London Hospitals (UCLH) cancer centre, you have been given an appointment to see your local CNS. Your local CNS in gynae-oncology is **Frances White.** Frances is part of a multidisciplinary team of healthcare professionals who will be looking after you following your treatment. She has specialist knowledge and experience in gynaecological cancers. Frances is based between Barnet Hospital and Chase Farm Hospital and is also linked with London Cancer, a network liaising with teams at UCLH and the Royal Free Hospital.

What happens during my appointment?

On the day of your appointment please attend the relevant clinic – the details are on your attached appointment letter. You will be seen by Frances, who will go through your treatment pathway with you, and give you individualised support and advice following the completion of your treatment.

After your appointment

At the end of your appointment, depending on your needs, a follow up appointment (either in person, or on the telephone) will be arranged.
