Patients First and Foremost

The gynaecological cancer unit at Barnet Hospital and Chase Farm Hospital

Barnet Hospital and Chase Farm Hospital, which are both part of the Royal Free London NHS Foundation Trust, form your local gynaecological cancer unit. This unit feeds into a larger network called London Cancer. Often, your initial diagnosis and some of your treatment may be given at Barnet Hospital or Chase Farm Hospital. However, if you require additional treatments, such as complex surgery, chemotherapy or radiotherapy, you are likely to be referred to University College Hospital London (UCLH), where they have a gynaecological cancer centre. As a world leader in research, it is here that suitable patients may be invited to participate in clinical trials.

The team

The gynaecological oncology unit team consists of consultant gynaecological surgeons, a specialist nurse, histocytologists and radiologists, all with the relevant training and experience in looking after women with gynaecological cancers. The team has access to clinical oncologists, medical oncologists and psychologists at the cancer centre at UCLH.

The multidisciplinary team (MDT) meets every Friday to discuss all new cases. Within the team there is a wealth of knowledge and experience which means patients will be given the best treatment and care.
