

# Your MRI scan at the Royal Free Hospital

Your scan is booked and will take place at the brand new mobile MRI unit in the south car park at the Royal Free Hospital.

When you come for your scan, head straight to the mobile MRI unit. You don't need to go to the main radiology department beforehand.

Parking at the hospital is limited, so it's best to take public transport to your scan if possible. There are also spaces for bikes if you are able to cycle. ## How to find the mobile MRI unit

From the main entrance to the hospital on Pond Street, head straight down the main corridor to the left of reception. You'll pass WHSmith on your left and an M&S cafe on your right.

Continue down the corridor, following signs to the south car park. When you reach the Katharine

Dormandy Haemophilia and Thrombosis Centre at the end of the corridor, turn right.

Continue straight, past the Sheila Sherlock Education Centre on your left and out the Rowland Hill street exit. Turn left out of the exit and follow the path left around under the bridge to the south car park.

As you come around the bend, you'll see the mobile MRI unit in the car park on your right. Go into the unit, where a member of staff will check you in for your scan.

## Coming from Belsize Park tube station

If you're coming from Belsize Park, exit the station and turn right onto Haverstock Hill. Continue for about five minutes, past a row of shops on your right. When you reach The George pub turn right onto Rowland Hill Street and go down the hill towards the Royal Free Hospital. Continue along path under the bridge and into the south car park.
