



Make your own Denim diary

What you need:

- The leg from an old pair of adult jeans
- Jean pocket (optional)
- Fabric paint
- Notebook or blank diary
- Hot glue or fabric glue

1. Cut a medium sized piece of denim from an adult pair of jeans. Make sure your piece of denim is just larger than the notebook you are covering.
2. Lay the notebook open so that the spine of the book lines up with the seam of the trouser leg. Trim the denim around the book so that you have about 3cm all around the notebook to fold in.
3. Fold in and glue the edges of the denim to the inside cover of the diary.
4. Cut slits at the seam/spine area of the book allowing you to fold in the edges neatly.
5. Glue down the first and last page of the notebook so that they cover the denim edges inside the book.
6. You can also glue a pocket from some jeans on to the front of the notebook to hold your pens etc, you can then decorate the cover as you like with fabric glue or pens.
7. Leave your diary to dry and then enjoy your personalized denim diary!



Make your own denim pocket magnets

What you need:

-Denim jean pockets cut from old jeans

-Fabric paint/pens

-Lace trim or ribbon trim

-Ribbon flowers (optional)

-Fridge magnet

-Hot glue or craft glue

1. Carefully cut out the pockets from a pair of jeans.
2. Glue lace or any fabric trim around the top of the pocket. You can also glue on jewels or other accessories if you please.
3. Write "Notes" or whatever you wish on the front with fabric paint/pens.
4. Glue a magnet to the back of each denim pocket and stick the fridge. Enjoy!
