

## The Leighs Village Summer Show

July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2018. from 2pm on Village Green.

Following last year's very successful Charity Dog Show, Boot Sale & Teas & Cakes afternoon, this year we will be including a Village Summer Show, that will run alongside the other events.

The Show, so popular in days gone by, with the last one being in 2004, will give everyone the opportunity to get together and show their home-made produce, vegetables, flowers, flower arranging, home baking, craft work, children's classes and much more, in a marquee on the village green (weather permitting) or in the village hall.

Past shows were superb, a blaze of colour and scent from the wonderful flowers and flower arranging, fantastic fruit & vegetables, excellent craft work, and the most amazing and creative children's classes.

To give everyone the opportunity to start planting and growing, listed below are the classes in each section.

### Section 1. Fruit & Vegetables.

- 1) 5 Broad beans on a plate
- 2) 9 peapods on a plate
- 3) 1 Lettuce with 2" root.
- 4) 1 Cabbage with 2" stem
- 5) 3 Carrots on a plate
- 6) 5 Tomatoes on a plate
- 7) 1 Bowl of 10 Strawberries
- 8) 1 Bowl of 20 Raspberries.

### Section 2. Flowers Flower arranging & Plants

- 9) Table arrangement, no larger than 12" (30cms) diameter
- 10) Vase with 5 mixed roses
- 11) Vase with 5 single roses
- 12) Vase with mixed garden flowers
- 13) Yellow flower arrangement
- 14) Flower arrangement in a wine glass
- 15) Flowering plant
- 16) Variegated leaf plant
- 17) Bowl of pansies
- 18) Bowl of mixed plants no larger than 12" (30cms) diameter.
- 19) Small hanging basket.

### Section 3. Wine & Home Baking.

- 20) Wine: Red
- 21) Wine: White
- 22) Wine: Rose'
- 23) Small decorated cake (Flower theme decoration only)
- 24) Shortbread (7" tin)
- 25) Fruit Cake (8" tin)
- 26) 6 Fruit Scones
- 27) 6 Plain Scones
- 28) Victoria sponge cake
- 29) 6 Chocolate Brownies
- 30) 6 Decorated Cup Cakes

### Section 4. Miscellaneous

- 31) Example of embroidery
- 32) Small cross stitch picture
- 33) Small Dried or silk flower arrangement
- 34) Wooden item
- 35) Hand Knitted Garment
- 36) Patchwork item
- 37) Example of machine embroidery
- 38) Water colour Painting
- 39) Oil Painting
- 40) Most humorous photograph of your pet animal (framed)

### Section 5. Children's Classes (up to 16 yrs)

- 41) Animal made from vegetable.
- 42) Seed Tray Garden
- 43) Decorated your own Gingerbread man (either homemade or bought biscuit)
- 44) 6 Chocolate crispy cakes
- 45) Design Your Favourite Super hero card
- 46) Friendship Bracelet
- 47) Posy of Flowers

***As you can see there are many classes to enter, hopefully something for everyone. (see show rules overleaf)***

**Show Rules and Directions**

- 1) All produce exhibited must be made or grown by the exhibitor and no exhibit can be entered in more than one class.
- 2) Only one entry can be made in each class.
- 3) 50p entry fee for each class entered (Children's classes FREE) **Money to be submitted with entry form**
- 4) All entries to be brought to show Marquee between 9.30 and 10.30am on the day.
- 5) Judging will commence from 11am, only judges and secretaries to be present during this time. Judge's decision is final.
- 6) Points, plus 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place certificates will be awarded for each class. Children's class winners will receive rosettes. In addition, a trophy will be awarded for the most aggregate points scored in the adult and children's combined classes, so the more classes entered the greater chance of winning.
- 7) All items must remain on display until 4.30pm
