Terms: ALL dogs must be kept on a lead; FLEXI-LEADS ARE NOT PERMITTED; DOGS MUST wear visible identification tags on their collars; NO PUPPIES under the age of 16 weeks are allowed entry into the show ring without discussion from the steward; ONE DOG one handler rule; OWNERS must have poo bags on them at all times; CLASSES will run one after the other; £1 entry fee per class given on entry to the ring JUDGE'S decision is final; IMAGES of event, including winners will be used for public viewing, e.g. social media and post-event news pieces.

Set up Time: 1.30-2pm

Fees: £8 per vehicle

Pitches must be pre-booked; contact Anne 01245 361481; leave a message with your full name, tel. number, & type of car.

Terms: PITCHES must be pre-booked; ALL bookings to be made by 5pm the day before the event; PITCHES will be allocated on a first come first bases; PITCHES are for cars & 4x4s, other vehicles will only be allowed entry at event organisers discretion; TABLE TOP PITCH (i.e. without a vehicle) is permitted & will be charged at the same rate (owner must provide own table etc.); 100% of pitch fees go to Essex Air Ambulance; DRIVERS must be set up by 2pm and can leave after 4.30pm for public safety; PITCHES will be allocated on the day by stewards; FEES will be collected on the day after set-up; USERS can promote their own pitches on the day; CHARITY PITCHES are permitted, £8 pitch fee still applies.
