The current owners have been in occupation since 1995 and restored the property in full.

The extended property comprises of spacious well laid out accommodation comprising of entrance lounge, entrance hallway, guest w.c., drawing room, sitting room, family room, sun lounge, kitchen / breakfast room, utility room, 6 bedrooms (2 ensuite) and bathroom.

Outside the well manicured mature gardens are accessed via double wrought iron gates and original granite pillars.
