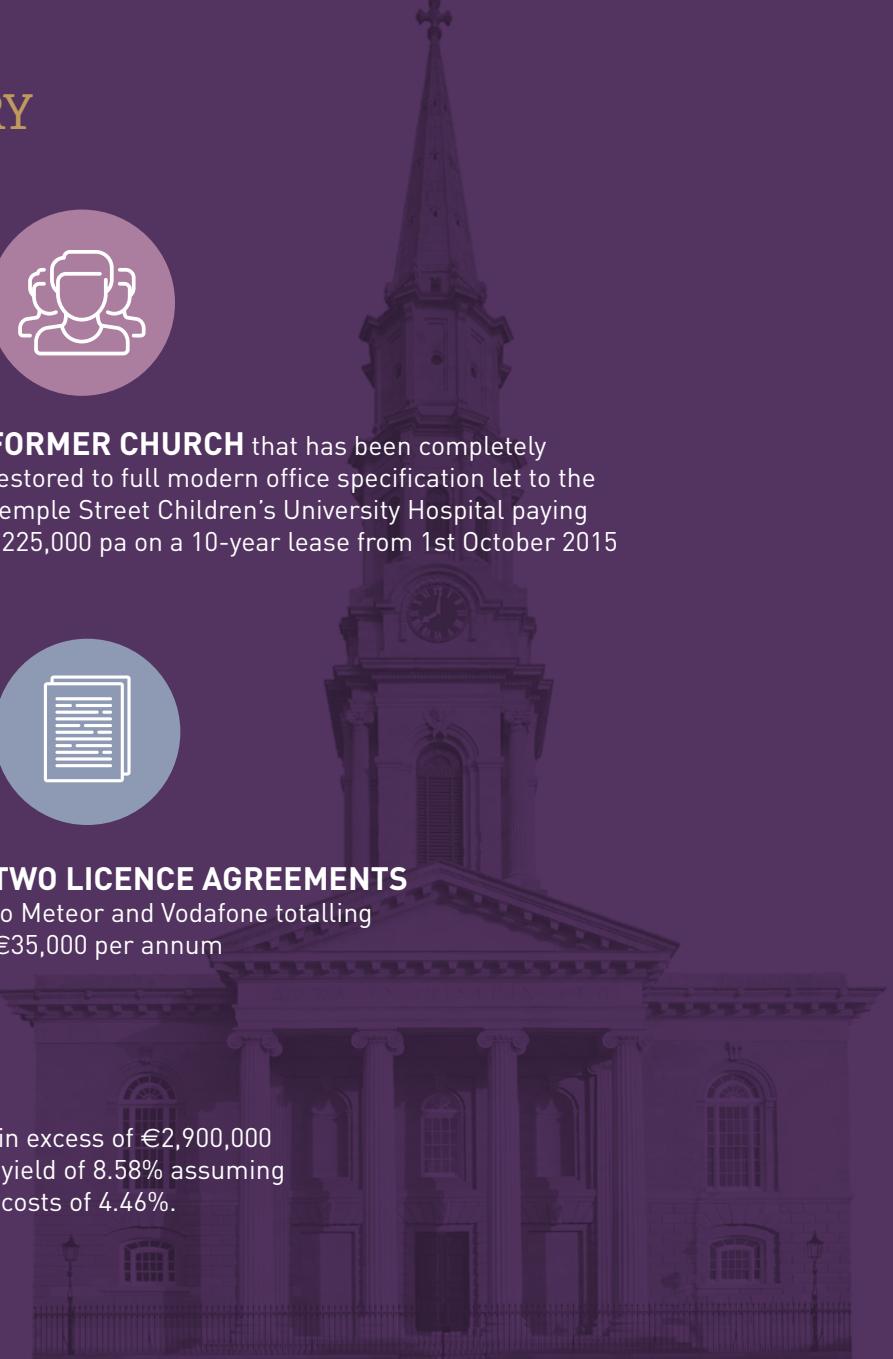

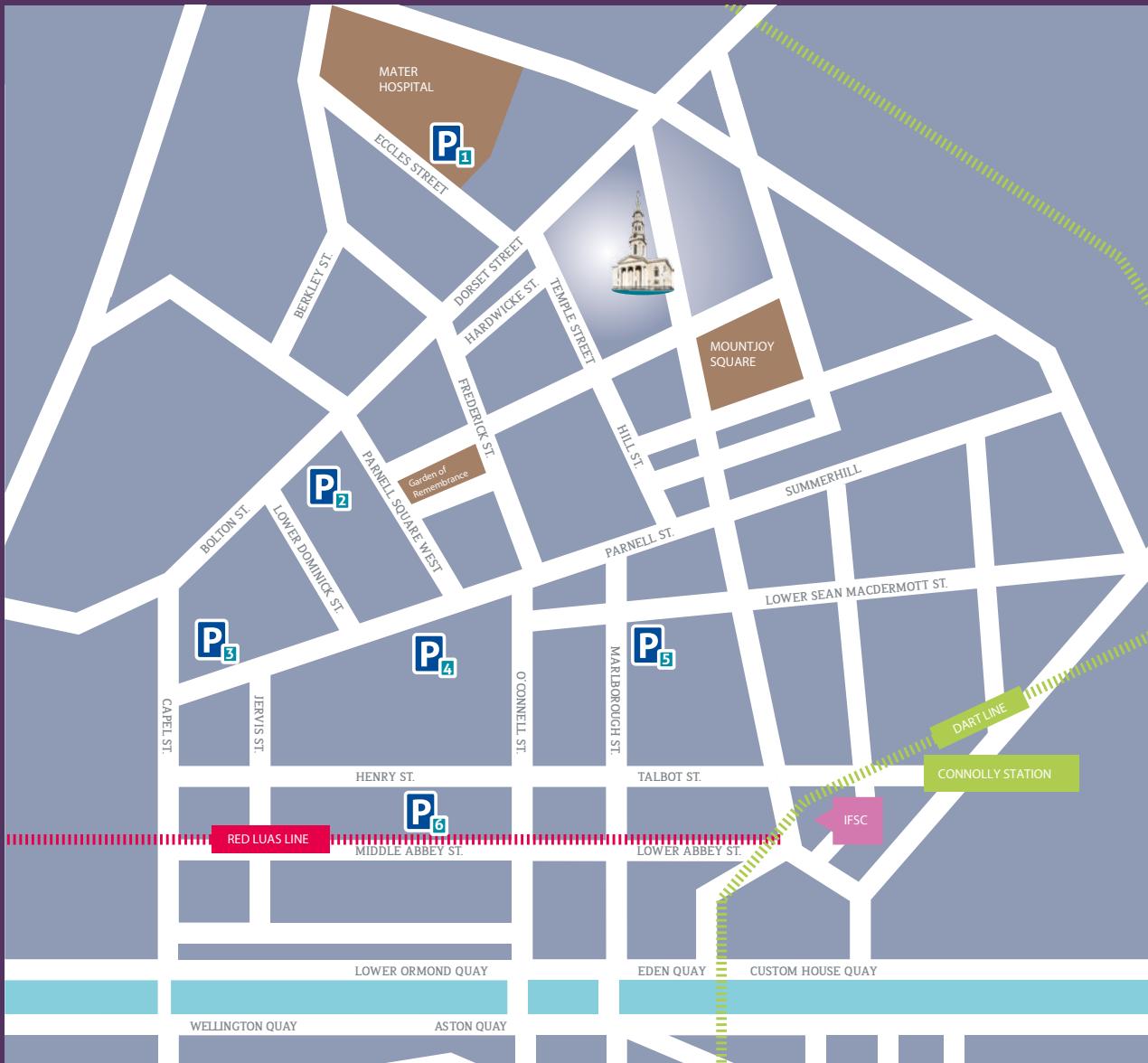

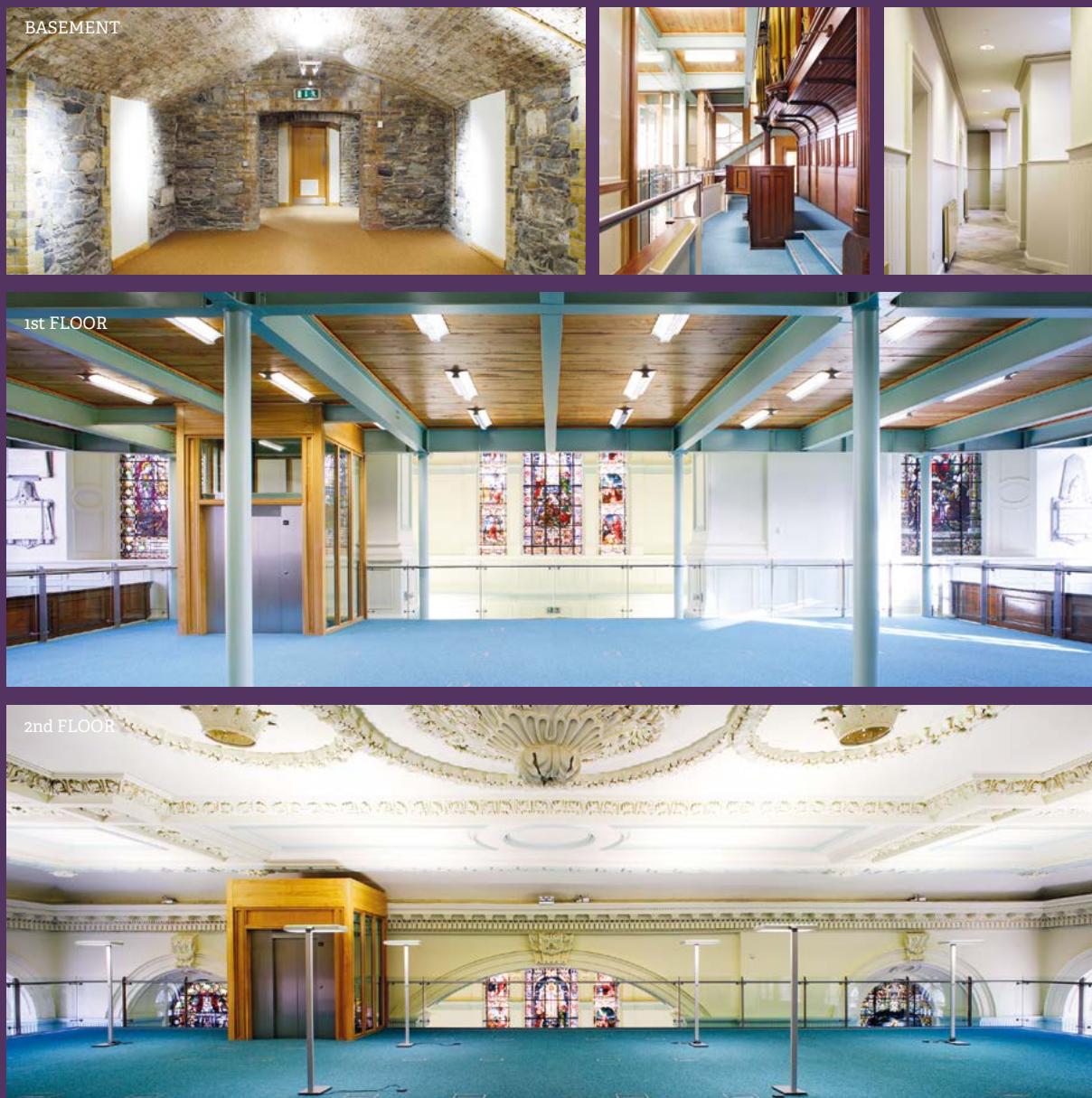
LOCATION

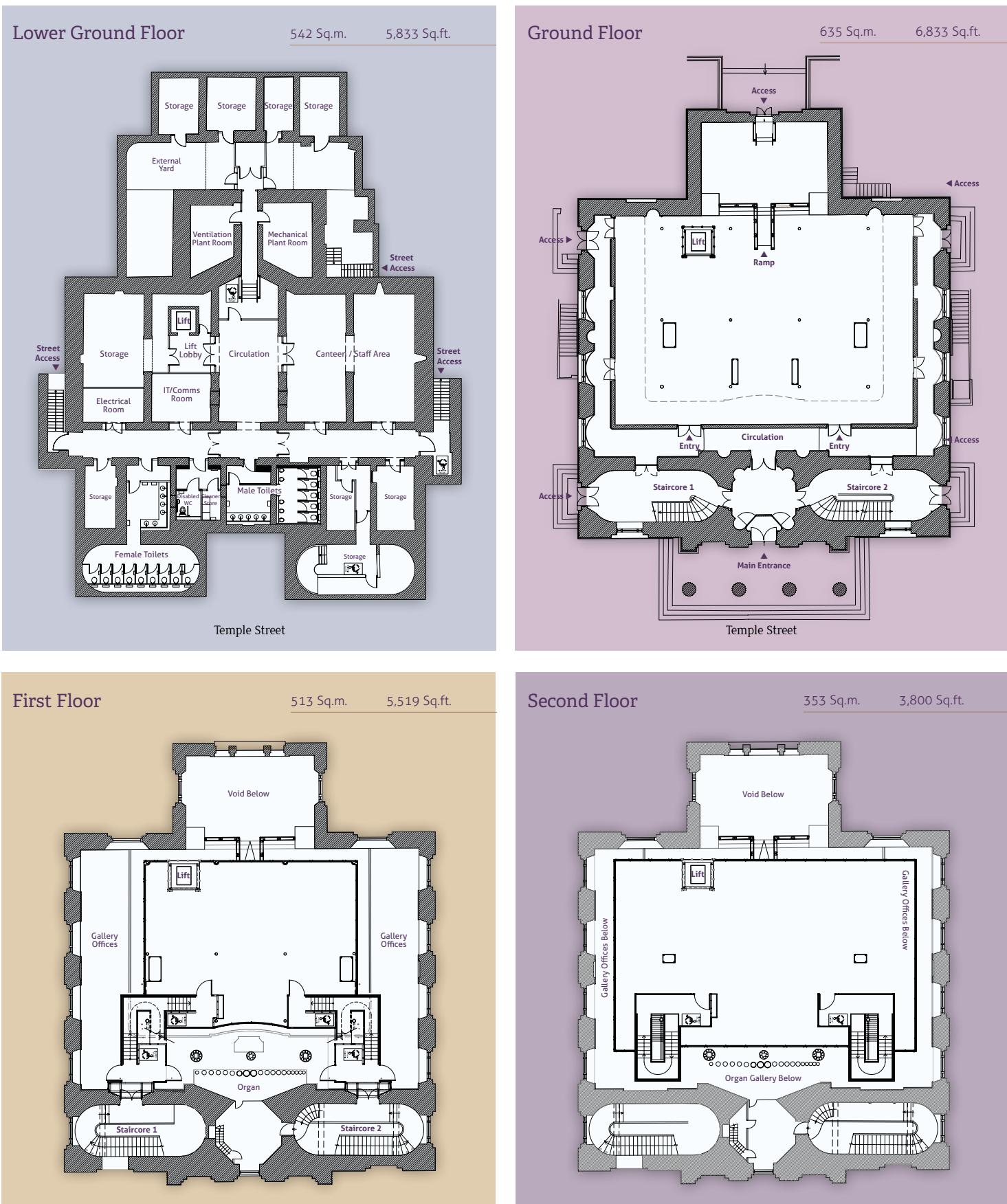
