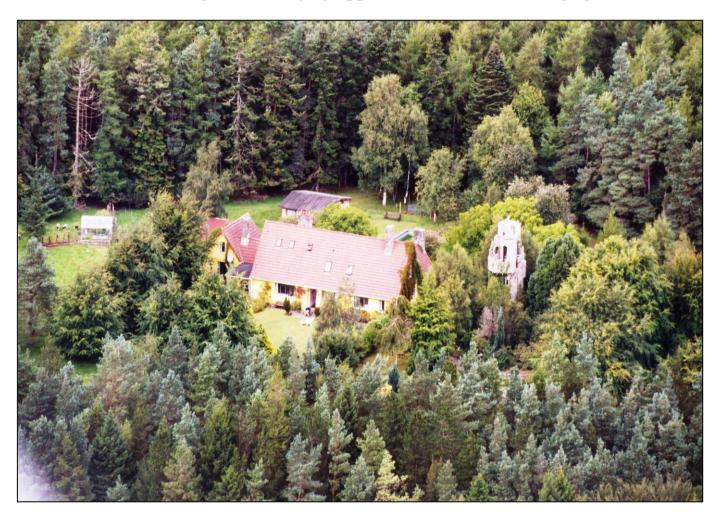

This truly is a property which boasts an abundance of character and olde world charm. The property is set amidst a very unique setting of c.10 acres of natural woodlands, it was designed in 1930 by Michael Scott the internationally renowned architect and it's uniqueness has ensured that a preservation order (protected structure 33-17 number 490) is in place. Some of the many features which the property has to offer include an outdoor swimming pool, a guest chalet, walled gardens and the old tower which has been fully restored and offers spectacular views. Viewings are strictly by appointment with sole selling agents.

Entrance Hall c. 3.76m x c. 4.70m

Wooden floor, radiator x 2, spiral staircase, timber ceiling, open fireplace.

Kitchen c. 6.54m x c. 2.63m

To rear aspect, tiled floor, solid fuel range, hob, brick featured walls over front garden.

Utility c. 2.3m x c. 2.04m

To rear aspect, wooden floor, plumbed for washing machine door to kitchen and dining room.

Sunroom/Dining Room c. 3.67m x c. 5.4m

Steps down from sitting room, tiled floor, radiator x 2, timber ceiling, timber wall panelling and stone walls.

Sitting Room c. 4.62m x c. 6.93m

Solid wood floor, to front aspect, stone open fireplace, timber ceiling beams, sliding doors to dining room, arch into kitchen, overlooking rear gardens, radiator x 3.

Family Room c. 4.72m x c. 7.1m

Door to rear garden, radiator x 3, solid wood floor, overlooking front and rear garden, fitted shelving, stairs to attic room, solid fuel stove, light filled room.

Bathroom c. 1.58m x c. 2.12m

Bath, wc, wash hand basin, wooden floor, radiator.

Rooms over family room

Study c. 2.96m x c. 3.56m Carpet to floor, window to rear aspect

Bedroom One c. 3.23m x c. 4.56m

Carpet to floor, wash hand basin, to front window to side aspect.

WC c. 1.63m x 1.87m

Between kitchen and entrance hall , wooden floor, wc, wash hand basin, window to back, radiator.

Bedroom Two c. 3.2m x c. 4.75m

To front aspect, wooden floor, wash hand basin, timber ceiling, solid fuel stove, walk in wardrobe, potential for ensuite, wooden floor.

Master Bedroom c. 3.99m x c. 5.31m

To front aspect, wooden floor, radiator x2, built in wardrobe, open fire with stone fireplace and mantle. The Ensuite c. 2.19m x c. 2.52m Sunken bath, wc, wash hand basin, radiator, fully tiled, shower over bath, timber ceiling, b-day.

Bedroom Three c. 5.36m x c. 3.81m

Wooden floor, upstairs, family room, timber ceiling, radiator x 2, fireplace, built in wardrobe. Ensuite c. 2.74m x c. 1.91m Wash hand basin, wc, b-day, bath and shower overhead, wooden ceiling and wall panelling, velux window, tiled floor.

Bedroom Four c. 3.03m x c. 3.2m

Wash hand basin, shower, wc, radiator, velux window, single room, wooden floor, timber ceiling.

Main Bathroom c. 2.78m x c. 2.91m

To rear aspect, wc, wash hand basin, bath, tiled floor, ½ walls, radiator, b-day.









Chalet

Main living area and kitchen c. 3.73m x c. 4.92m Timber frame throughout, wooden floor, fitted kitchen units, Apex style window.

Bedroom One c. 2.47m x c. 4.43m Carpet to floor, built in wardrobe, wash hand basin, to rear aspect.

Bedroom Two c. 2.49m x c. 2.44m Carpet to floor, wooden ceiling, built in wardrobe, wash hand basin, to rear aspect.

Bathroom c. 1.76m x c.1.61m

Heated towel rail, wash hand basin, wc, bath and shower overhead, wooden floor, tiled bath surround.
