Market

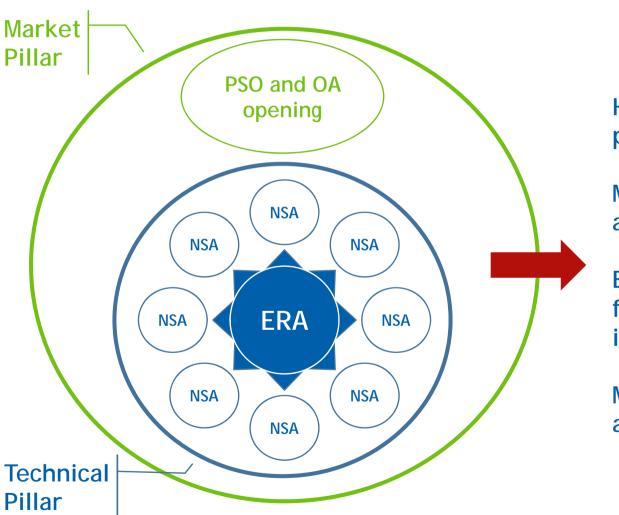
Rail legislative packages enforcing progressive market opening

Higher competitive pressure

More legal certainty across borders

Better environment for private investments

More standardisation achievable

Market Pillar



More independent IMs

► Less dual memberships in boards; better impartial essential functions, traffic management and maintenance planning; increased financial transparency.

ENIM is established

► IMs will deal with best practices, monitoring performance, tackling cross-border bottlenecks.

Opened domestic passenger mkts

▶ Domestic mkts open for commercial services and PSO. PSO direct award still possible. PSO financial equilibirum is protected.

Promoted ticketing schemes

the Commission will report by December 2022 on the status of development of an information and ticketing scheme.

Market Pillar



PSO undercompensation not ruled out

► EP and Council agreed on an explicit prohibition of undercompensation only in the form of a recital.

Current social standards are kept

Whatever is binding today remains binding – but nothing more than that.

Rolling stock: still a barrier to enter the market

Competent authorities shall assess whether measures are necessary to ensure effective and non-discriminatory access to suitable rolling stock.

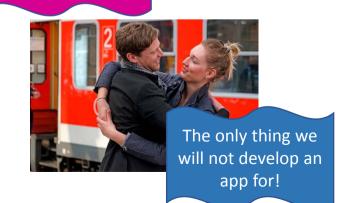








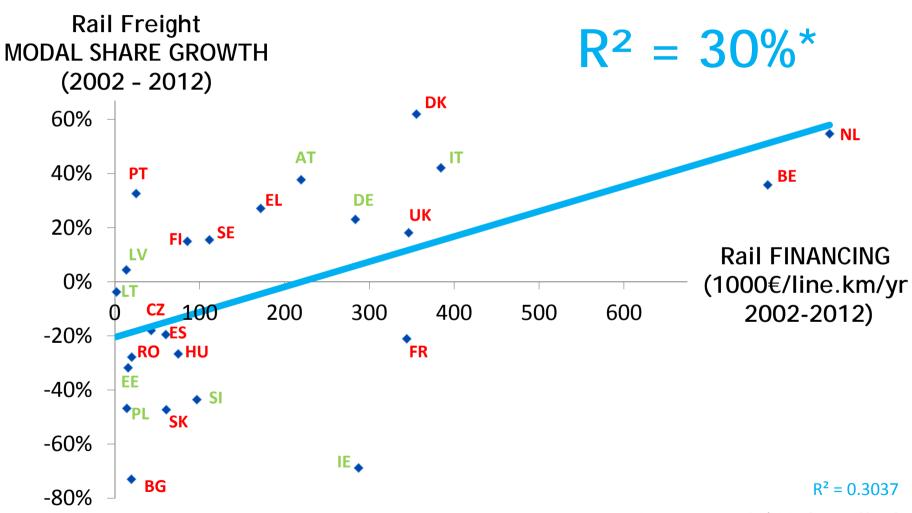

Road pricing: 99% of the road network and 50% of the motorway network is not tolled, with very high noninternalised external costs
