

## PortAventura prepares for big scares with a monstrous Halloween of horror

- The top attractions this year will be the real-life presence of the hugely successful **Monster High** dolls and the thrilling **Pasaje [REC]** ride, which recreates the best moments from **[REC]4 Apocalipsis**, the final movie in the horror series.
- From **27th September to 16th November**, **PortAventura Resort** will be taken over by zombies and ghosts and other supernatural creatures of the dark.

As the result of a partnership with the multinational toy company **Mattel**, PortAventura will present the world premier of **Monster High's** live show in the México area's **La Cantina**, starting on **October 4th**. **Frankie Stein**, **Draculaura**, **Clawdeen Wolf**, **Cleo de Nile** and **Lagoona Blue** will come to life in a jawdropping performance for all the family.

Another new addition for 2014 is **Pasaje [REC]**, the hair-raising horror ride inspired by the famous movie series. The recreation of the most spine-chilling moments of the latest film, **[REC]4 Apocalipsis**, which opens in cinemas on **October 31st**, will delight white-knuckled fans of horror and suspense. The



ride also gives visitors the chance to experience some of the scariest moments from the other movies in the series, [REC], [REC] 2 and [REC] 3.



Those who still feel like screaming can also brave the legendary **"Selva de Miedo"**, an outdoor terror walk through the Polynesia area's jungle. Monstrous beings lurk in the darkness, ready to chill the blood of visitors who enter in search of fun and frights. Bold guests can also face **"Horror en Penitence"**, a macabre and inhospitable maze in the Far West from whose gloom and creepy atmosphere it is difficult to escape.

### Fun and entertainment for all the family

Fun is guaranteed in PortAventura thanks to the many shows that take place in a park transformed by the spirit of Halloween. Visitors of all ages will experience both grins and goose-bumps as they enjoy the entertainment offered in every area of the park. Those who go to Emma's House restaurant in the Far West zone will find it converted into "La Posada de la Familia Halloween". They will have the chance to meet the macabre family in a horror-comedy spectacular where every dish hides a terribly funny surprise.

Lovers of mystery and music can't miss the incredible **"Rock Symphony"**, a unique show in which dancers and acrobats perform in a grim and gothic atmosphere to summon the souls from the beyond. Younger visitors will adore **"iEs Halloween en SésamoAventura!"**, a family-friendly alternative to the scary goings-on in which Sesame Street's Count Von Doom and his friends present a fun show where anything's possible.

Don't forget the legendary **"Love for Vampires"**, a mystery show set in the old castle of Penitence, where Alexei, master of darkness, and his beautiful maidens find themselves in danger from a vampire hunter determined to exterminate them. In another great acrobatic show, **"Bang Bang Halloween"**, a small band of soldiers and a vampire's apprentice must defend Penitence, turning it into a blood bank for all of the zone's vampires and even Count Dracula himself.

The Mediterrània area will again host the majority of the night-time programme, a highlight of which is the **"Halloween Parade"** that brings an end to every day's events. A colourful collection of vehicles will be taking part, including an old horse-drawn hearse, a cute pumpkin, a giant skeleton riding a bicycle, and a huge demon. In **"Horror en el lago"**, the Mediterrània zone's lake will
