Wow what a busy week at Bugle School!

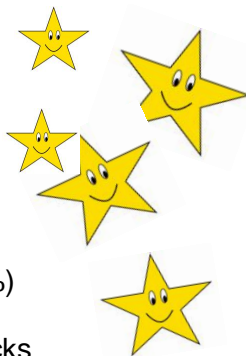

**Starting school or transferring to a secondary school** is an important step for your child. Cornwall Council want to make the process of applying for a school place as easy as possible.

**Reception Class** If your child was born between 1 September 2013 and 31 August 2014 you will need to apply for a school place for September 2018. **The deadline for applications is 15 January 2018.**

If you submit an application by 15 January 2018 you will be sent a letter in the post on 16 April 2018 telling you which school you have been allocated. If you opted through the online application system to also be notified by email, you will receive this on 16 April 2018.

**Secondary School** If your child is currently in year six of a junior or primary school, you will need to apply for a place in year seven in a secondary school for September 2018. **The deadline for applications is 31 October 2017.**

If you submit an application by 31 October 2017 you will be sent a letter in the post on 1 March 2018 telling you which school you have been allocated. If you opted through the online application system to also be notified by email, you will receive this on 1 March 2018.
