Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the Summer Term.

A huge thank you to all of you who supported the 'Apprentice' event at the end of last term. The class making the greatest profit this time was Year 5 who made £132.30. Congratulations to Year 5 but also to all the children in every class for their imaginative products and activities.

This term we are delighted to be working with the National Literacy Trust on their Reading challenge. This will involve Years 1, 2 and 3 although there will be an opportunity for Years 4, 5 and 6 to get involved with the final part of the challenge. There will be 3 reading events taking place over the next term: Y1, 2 and 3 are invited to come back to school for a 'bedtime story' session on the 24<sup>th</sup> May, from 6 until 7 pm, as part of their first challenge, as well as to visit Drakes Circus for some storytelling workshops on the 21<sup>st</sup> June. The whole school will be holding a 'book-nic' during July to support them with the final part of the reading challenge. The date for that will be 14<sup>th</sup> July.

The children will soon be coming home with their home learning projects for this term. Once again we will be holding a series of after school 'drop-ins' where you are invited to come along and work with your children on their home learning project. The class teachers will be available to help and you are welcome to use the classroom resources to support their project work. The dates for these will be:

Class 1 and Class 2: 8<sup>th</sup> May and 19<sup>th</sup> June between 3:15-4pm

Class 3 and Class 4: 15<sup>th</sup> May and 26<sup>th</sup> June between 3:15-4pm

Class 5 and Class 6: 22<sup>nd</sup> May and 3<sup>rd</sup> July between 3:15-4pm

We will hold the home learning exhibition on the 19<sup>th</sup> July from 2:30-5:00pm in the school hall. More details will follow nearer the time.

Mrs Kelly is recovering from an operation so will not be back at school whilst her recovery takes place. She only received notification of this during the Easter holidays so we were not able to notify you before.
