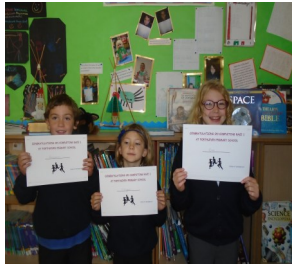


Cross Country

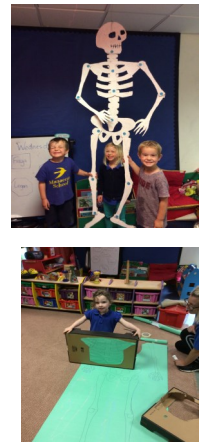


Transfer to Secondary School
