YEAR 6 SATS

They are finally here! The children will be sitting their SATS tests next week. The timetable will be as follows and all tests will take place in the morning. It is essential that children are in school on time.

Monday 8th May: Reading Test (1 hour)

Tuesday 9th May: Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling -Test (Paper 1 45 mins and Paper 2 20mins)

Wednesday 10th May: Maths Arithmetic Test Paper 1 (30 mins)

Maths Reasoning Paper 2 (40 mins)

Thursday 11th May: Maths Reasoning Paper 3 (40 mins)

Friday 12th May: NO TESTS! FUN DAY! - to celebrate the end of the tests (details to follow!)

The children have been working hard especially over the last weeks in preparation for these tests. I have spoken to the children about the importance of getting enough sleep, eating a good breakfast etc in order to be full of energy on the day.

This year the children are invited to come and have breakfast in school on the Monday and Thursday morning.

This will be available in the classroom when the children arrive at normal time. On Monday we will have cereals and juice available and Thursday (the last day of tests) there will be croissants on the menu! During the remainder of the week there will be fruit available in the classroom.

Also, there will be no homework during SATS week, so that the children can rest and relax when they get home.
