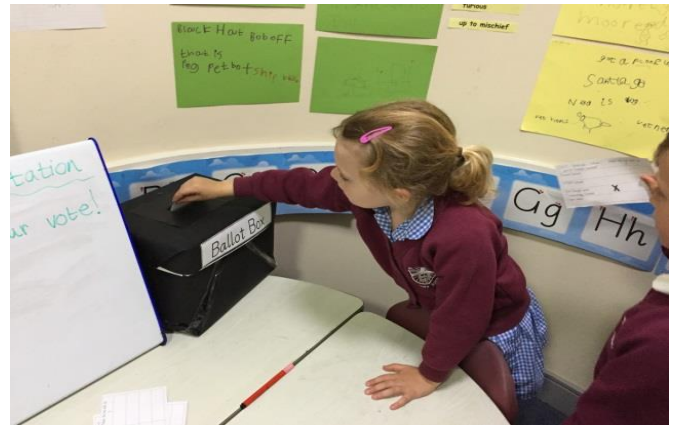
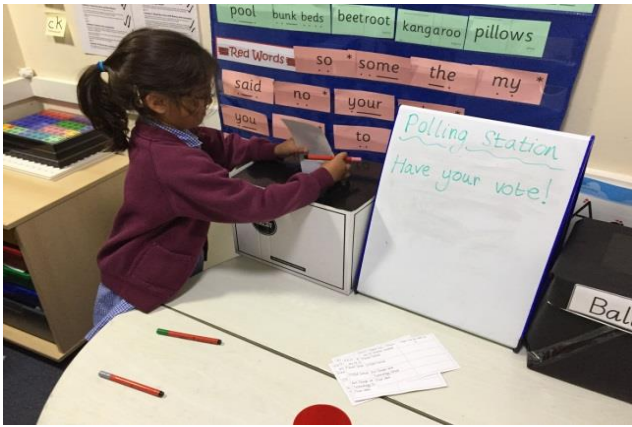
The results from the children's ballot were as follows:
