Thank you to those that have provided signed internet use agreements and particularly to those who attended the recent e-safety session for parents.

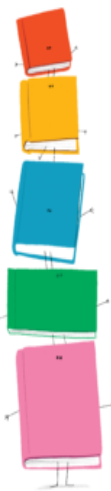
