**Due to KS2 SATs, there won't be any Wake and Shake next week. This will allow the Y6 children to come in and have breakfast before they take the tests.**

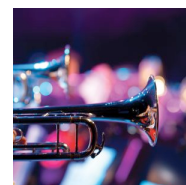
