## WEDNESDAY 14th JUNE 2017

Wednesday 14th June is our Sports Day and Race for Life. It will start (weather permitting!) at 9:15 am on the school field. All parents are very welcome to join us and to share your own picnic lunches with the children between 12 midday and 12:45pm. Sports day will run approx. 9.15am – 10.30am followed by Race for Life at approx. 11am

Could children please wear their House Team colours which are:

Please note children are to wear **t-shirts** and **not** sleeveless vests.

As we shall be going down to the field immediately after registration, if your child suffers with hayfever could you please ensure that they have had their medication BEFORE they come to school.

Could you also please ensure that your child has a named water bottle which is full. Sun screen protection should be applied BEFORE your child attends school. If you feel your child will need any further protection during the day, we ask they bring a spray sun cream into school as it is easier for them to apply. Staffs are not allowed to apply sun protection to children.

Please note our reserve sports day will be on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June at the same times as above.

**During lunchtime, and as a FINAL fundraiser for our Year 6 leavers trip, they will be selling ice creams. If you are able to join us and would like to purchase an ice cream for your child (and also for you!!) please keep the money with you until lunchtime and do not give your child any money to bring into school. If you are unable to join us, please send money in with your child on Wednesday morning but PLEASE put it in a named sealed bag/envelope as monies not secure may be lost and this causes upset.**

## **PARENT PAY—A Cashless Payment Solution for Schools and Families**

The school is considering using Parent Pay which is a facility whereby parents can make payment for various items, eg school meals, school uniform, school trips, donations and the like online. Those parents with children at Walton High School will already be familiar with the programme. This will cut the cost of administration and again help us in our efforts to reduce expenditure. The Parent Pay facility also allows you to, for example, consent to a school trip and to make menu choices for school meals. It is hoped to roll out information to parents regarding this facility after the Easter break for implementation after the half term break in May. Watch this space!!

## **All Saints Race for life!**

This year we have decided to host a school race for life event. We are going to be holding it as part of our sports day celebrations on Wednesday 14th June. Normal sports day races will take place on the school field from 9.15am and parents are invited to come and support their children and to stay with us for the morning. The sports day will be slightly condensed and then straight afterwards we will then do the race for life. This will involve splitting the school into two groups, class one and two will do theirs running or walking laps of the school sports field whilst class 3 and 4 will be completing their run/ walk along School lane towards Teddesley and back again, finishing on the school field. The route will be well supervised and local neighbours/farmers will be informed. Permission slips and sponsorship details will be going out separately next week. Each child taking part will receive a medal, If parents would like to run or walk alongside their child this would be great and perhaps a way of gaining even more sponsorship! ( unfortunately I only have medals for the children at All Saints) following the race for life and sports day activities you are warmly invited, as always, to have a picnic lunch on our field with your children. Portaloos will be provided. Children will be taken back to school for 1pm. Please note should the weather be poor we will try again the week after, Wednesday 21st June.

If you are available to be a supervisor for the run/walk up the lane, please let Mrs Scott or Wendy Winbush know, this will involve standing along the route in a hi vis jacket and making sure the children are going the correct way!
