Hendra—Kieran Hibberd for being kind and considerate around the school and his excellent effort in class.

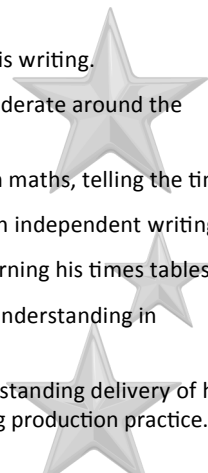
Prosper—Casey Ralph-Buckley for super effort in maths, telling the time.
