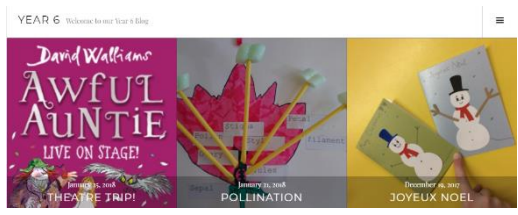


Take a look at our class blog! This will feature just some of our exciting learning in school.
