We took part in lots of different games like, "Catch Me If You Can", "Hula Hula", "Jolly Volleyball", "Fun

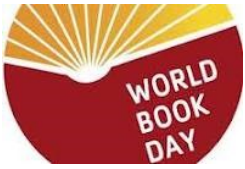
Shutters", "Dan Devil Dribble" and "Battimull Alley"
