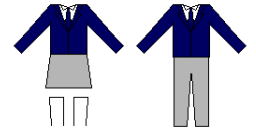
Lost Uniform

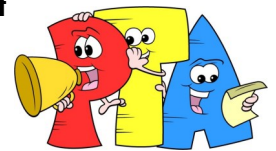


Summer Fayre
