Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra

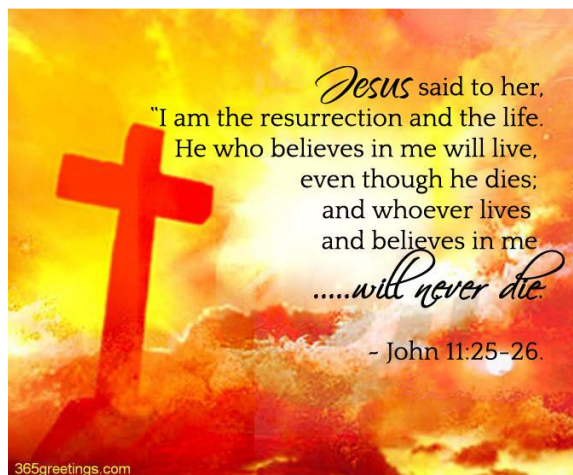
