We are really proud of the children for coming in brilliantly the first two weeks of their schooling life. Next week, we start our full week, the doors open from 8.35am – 8.55am and will reopen for collection 3.10pm – 3.25pm. We will continue finding out and learning the structure and routines of Treverbyn. Last week we started our Literacy programme Read, Write, Inc. and learnt the sound m,a,s,d and t. This week's sounds will be i,n,p,g and o. Please practice these sounds at home with your child and encourage them to start making words (for example m-a-d, mad). In maths we will be doing a bit of baking and using scales to balance out the ingredients and continuing to count to 10.

Porthpean

Next week, the children will continue to work on place value in maths including counting forwards and backwards. The children will continue to work on their reading and writing during their Read Write Inc sessions. We will continue our topic work by planning a celebration, learning what is important when organising a special event. Plymouth Argyle sessions will continue with a focus on football and we will be looking at the creation story from the Bible.

Virtues

Class news continued.....

Pendower

Year Two have been learning about Pudding Lane. We made our own bread and chef hats as if we were workers back in 1666. We have also been starting to learn how to join our letters together to make our writing look even neater! We are excited to learn more about where The Great Fire of London started next week.

Charlestown

Next week in Year 3, we will begin our week with our exciting visit to Wheal Martyn, which will extend our understanding of rocks and soils. We will be moving on to look at the structure of the earth and how plate tectonics cause earthquakes and volcanoes. In English we will be rewriting part of the text 'Vacation Under the Volcano', using inverted commas (speech marks) to show when characters are talking. In maths we will be continuing to work on solving place value problems, identifying the value of each part of a 3 digit number, including zero as a place holder.

Whipsiderry

Next week in Year 4 we will be continuing to look at place value in maths working with 4 digit numbers. In English we will be comparing characters from our class book 'The Iron Man' and creating descriptive paragraphs for them. On Wednesday we will begin our swimming lessons for this term.

Porthcurno

Next week in literacy Porthcurno/Year 5 will be writing letters. By the end of the week their letters will be in the correct formation with lots of complex sentences full of comparative phrases and adjectives. In Maths we will be working on place value and numbers up to a million. In topic we will be continuing to look at evacuation, leading to looking at the different types of aeroplanes used during World War 2.

Pentewan

Next week in year 6 will be continuing with our topic writing about the Titanic. In maths we will be revisiting place value.
