### P.E Kits

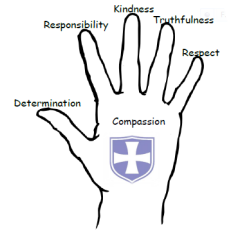
Please, please can we remind parents/carers that P.E. kits must be in school every day of the week. Thank you.
