### **Arrangements for the End of the School Day**

It is the school's duty to ensure pupils are safe in school and that they leave school safely at the end of the school day. At the end of the school day, staff must hand the children into the care of a responsible person, unless we have permission to do otherwise. For example, there may be certain times of the year when you might wish older children to walk home unaccompanied. I am therefore writing to remind you that your child must be collected by a responsible person over the age of 16.

If you are happy for your child to leave school unaccompanied, please complete the reply slip below and return it to school by Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September. From Monday 25<sup>th</sup> September, children will only be allowed to leave the premises unaccompanied if we have received the form overleaf. Please note: Children leaving the After School Clubs must be collected by a responsible person over the age of 16.

We ask all those collecting children from years 2 to 6 to stand behind the wall on the Junior playground. This is so that the children and their teacher can have the space to see you. It would help if you can stand in the same area of the playground each day so that your child knows where to look for you. If you are collecting children from the infant building, please do not walk between the wall and the school, when teachers are seeing the children out.

If you wish to speak to your child's class teacher at the end of the day, please wait until the class have been dismissed so that the teacher can focus on the children's safety.
