When they arrive back, the children will return to the classroom to collect their belongings and will then leave from the Year 3 door or the side gate.

PE Kits—Important Please Read

Please can you make sure that children have their PE kits in school at all times. With the recent introduction of our Enrichment Afternoons on Wednesdays, it has been decided to introduce a standard PE kit for all years (previously Reception Class have not needed an outdoor PE kit). If a child does not have the correct PE kit with them, the school will, where possible, provide spare items for them to wear, however if items are not available, your child will be unable to take part.

The items for indoor PE are round necked white t-shirt, shorts or skort and black pumps (optional as children may be bare footed) It is not acceptable for a child to wear an outdoor PE kit for indoor PE.

The items for an outdoor PE kit are black tracksuit bottoms, black sweatshirt/zip up top and black or white trainers. The items should be plain black with no branding or other colours. Please, please, please remember to name all items as we have a lot of items in lost property because we don't know who they belong to.
