We will continue to run these sessions as part of the school's drive to keep children safe whilst using the internet and social media, so, watch out for dates.

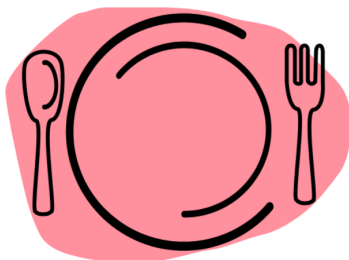


### Congratulations Ms Hatton
