The finale was Rocking all over the World sung by all children. It was a late night but everyone really enjoyed it. Don't the children look fab in their Songfest Tee Shirts!

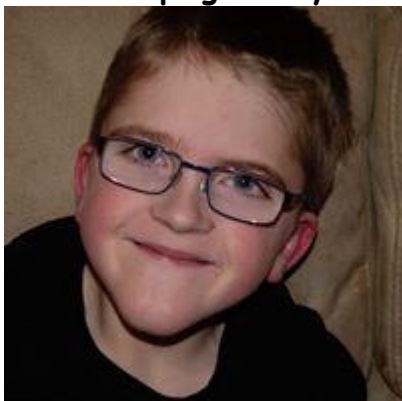


St Piran's Day Festival Saturday 4 March
