## White Wines

### Argentina

- 2 **Catena, Chardonnay, Mendoza, 2014** **£39.95**  
A fabulous crisp and elegant wine. Apple, melon and nutty peach fruit with a soft, creamy texture – all wrapped up in delicious wood tones.

### England

- 3 **Bolney Estate, Pinot Gris, 2015** **£49.00**  
Scented with rose, jasmine & pear.  
The creamy, fresh palate is rich & slightly honeyed.

### Australia

- 4 **The Spee'wah Semillon/Sauvignon Blanc, 2016** **£26.35**  
From the Darling River near the Ellerslie farming station, an Australian version of the classic old world style. This blend ticks all the boxes with its fresh citrus aromas and classic grassy finish lingering on the palate.
- 5 **Battle of Bosworth Chardonnay, 2015** **£35.90**  
The wine has a hint of “struck match” and citrus on the nose, tree fruit and citrus on the palate along with long, fine acid length and exceptionally well integrated oak.

### Austria

- 8 **Petter Dolle Gaisberg Gruner Veltliner 2015** **£32.95**  
Part of the wine matured in French oak. Light gold, with green tints. Nose of peach, grapefruit, white pepper, wet stone; unusually for Gruner, lemon and grapefruit palate adds a distinct bitterness to it. White pepper returns on the finish. Some roundness and depth from the old wines and oak.

Stylish with a lovely body and impeccable balance. Fresh, steely and attractive value.

- 34 **Crozes hermitage, Domain Colombier, 2013** **£42.75**  
Perfumed, floral notes of honeysuckle, lemon and spice. Full-bodied with a lovely weight of apricot fruit and slightly creamy, spicy oak. Fresh and clean on the finish.
- 35 **Condrieu, Les Ravines, Robert Niero, 2008** **£60.50**  
Voluptuous honeyed apricot and aromatic floral notes on the nose. Full bodied, dry and intense with further apricot and hints of dried fruits. A long silky finish.

## Germany

- 36 **Riesling, Pfalz JL Wolf, 2015** **£26.90**  
An off-dry Riesling with honeyed, peachy, green apple fruit on both the nose and palate.

## New Zealand

- 40 **Satellite, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, 2016 - 2017** **£32.95**  
A refreshing crisp structure with abundant flavours in the citrus and herbal spectrum.
- 41 **Alana, Riesling, Martinborough, 2013** **£46.90**  
Alana estate Riesling is slightly off dry with fantastic harmony of sugar, acid and complex aromatics.
- 42 **Dog Point, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, 2015** **£38.90**  
Following on from the 2013, James Healy and Ivan Sutherland's 2014 Sauvignon Blanc is a winner.

## Spanish Wine

- 43 **A Coroa Godello, 2013** **£31.95**  
A full bodied Spanish wine. Try this if you want something full bodied, rich, round and a bit different.
- 44 **Rioja, Chardonnay - Castillo Clavijo, 2016** **£30.95**  
Made from a blend of Viura, Malvasia and white Garnacha grapes, combining the bright, citrus freshness of the fruit with the honey and clove complexity from fermenting in oak barrels.

## Italy

- 47 **Corte Vigna Chardonnay, 2016** £17.50  
*This aromatic wine is fruity with a lovely peach and nectarine finish.*
- 48 **Pinot Grigio delle Venezie 2016** £26.00  
*Shows citrusy aromas, white flower blossom and a hint of mint, backed by a zesty and fresh palate.*

## South African White

- 49 **Cullinan View Chenin Blanc, 2017** £22.00  
Easy Drinking. Crisp ripe pear on the nose with a citrus finish.
- 50 **Waterford, Chardonnay, Stellenbosch, 2014** £41.50  
Clear, green straw tints. Elegant toastiness on the nose. Pure, refreshing citrus notes. Grapefruit, lime and juicy kiwi on the palate. Understated, rich finesse, restrained by refreshing acidity. A long balanced finish.
- 46 **Viognier, Flagstone Word of Mouth, Western Cape, 2018** £31.50  
The grapes for this 100% Viognier come from the cool-climate regions of Elgin and Elim, well known for producing high quality fruit. Aromas of fresh, ripe watermelon and juicy peach are encased in a delicate hint of spice. Medium-bodied but with a richness to the palate, common to Viognier, the wine finishes fresh, again with hints of Oriental spice.

## United States of America White

- 51 **Truchard, Chardonnay, Napa Valley, 2013** £44.85  
A classy Chardonnay from the U.S.A.  
Rich, creamy and buttery, this wine is exquisitely made.
- 52 **Dry Creek Vineyard, Fume Blanc, Unoaked Sauvignon, 2013** £33.95  
A nice zesty citrus aroma and flavour with hints of grapefruit. It has a lovely crisp, lean and clean finish with a touch of mineral flavour at the end. Not a long and lingering finish, but one that is pure and very satisfying.

## Rose Wines

- 53 Parini Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy, 2017 £22.50**  
*Soft, coppery-pink colour, delicate and fruity bouquet, soft and fresh on the palate.*
- 54 Don Jacobo Rioja Rosado, Spain, 2016 £24.85**  
A beautifully deep-coloured rosé made using a blend of the red grapes Garnacha and Tempranillo.
- 55 Whispering Hills White Zinfandel, California, 2016 £20.00**  
A beautiful deep salmon-pink coloured wine with loads of fresh summer-fruit flavours and lively acidity. Made in a medium style to appeal to a wide range of tastes.
- 57 Sancerre Rose, Domaine de Terres Blanches, France, 2012 £43.95**  
The Pinot Noir grapes for this amber rosé are grown in vineyards mainly in the district of Bué, the terroirs are described as 'caillotes', hard limestone, and 'terres blanches', white stones. The juice for the wine is obtained by direct cold pressing. This is clarified by static settling and fermented at low temperature in temperature-controlled vats. This rosé then undergoes a few months ageing in vat to keep its fruity character. Amber in colour, with flamingo-pink highlights; it shows redcurrant and berry fruit on the nose and a finessed, drawn-out finish.

## Dessert Wines

- 59 Muscat De Rivesaltes, Els Pyreneus, 50cl, 2015 £28.95**  
Brilliant yellow colour, intense, fresh nose with spicy grape aromas and hints of roses. On the palate the sweetness of summer fruits is beautifully balanced of natural acidity.
- 60 Béres Tokaji Aszú 5 Puttonyos, 50cl, 2008 £65.95**  
Tokaji, the great sweet wine of Hungary (the name coming from the Tokaj-Hegyalja region) is made predominantly using the Furmint grape variety. In 1730, long before classification systems were employed in Portugal and France to guarantee the wines pedigree, they were instigated in Hungary specifically for this regal wine. The wine spends two years maturing in oak barrels; it is incredibly sweet, with around 150 g/l residual sugar, flavours of dried apricot, fig and lime sit alongside a fabulous balancing acidity that leaves the palate refreshed.
- 62 Chateau du Cros, Loupiac, 2002 £63.70**  
A great alternative to Sauternes.

## Red Wines

### Argentina

- 63 Tilia Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot, Mendoza, 2016 £25.95**  
Very Intense aromas here, especially notes of red fruits and cassis. Herbal notes like rosemary, together with notes of vanilla and caramel give complexity to the wine. Important structure and aromatic persistence this wine stands out for its intense fruity taste. Soft and mature tannins give the wine its sweet and fruity structure.
- 64 Arido Malbec Mendoza, 2015 £28.00**  
*Medium ruby-red, the nose shows red fruits and notes of dried fig; the palate is fruit led and fresh.*
- 65 Pinot Noir, Alamos, 2016 £28.95**  
An aromatic nose of ripe red fruits with notes of spice. The ripe raspberry, strawberry and cherry flavours are mixed with touches of vanilla and toast from light oak ageing.

### Australia

- 66 Berri Estates Shiraz, 2015 £22.00**  
*The palate shows excellent dark berry fruit flavours, soft tannins, mingled with a light touch of oak on the finish.*
- 68 Elderton, Shiraz/Cab. Sauvignon, 2014 £31.00**  
Unequivocally Australian, generous to a fault, with enticing sun-baked plum, spice and leather aromas, while the palate's very soft.

### England

- 70 Bolney Estate, Pinot Noir, 2016 £49.00**  
Soft berry fruit flavours & fine crisp acidity with soft tannins

## Chile

- 71 Alto Bajo, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2016 £24.85**  
Dark ruby colour. Aromas of black pepper, figs, mint and eucalyptus which lead to a clean, soft and rounded palate. Medium body, slightly rich, soft tannins and a long pleasant finish.
- 72 Alto Bajo, Merlot, 2015/2017 £24.85**  
Ruby red colour with purple tones. Intense fresh fruity aromas of blackberries and plums. Soft toasted notes mixed with sweet vanilla. Medium bodied, soft tannins and a pleasant finish.

## France,

### Beaujolais

- 74 Fleurie Château de Bellevue, 2014 £34.50**  
Robust, concentrated fruit flavours of strawberry and wild cherry marked by spicy undertones carry into this wine's firm, broad but soft palate.
- 75 Moulin-A-Vent, Domaine de La Passion, Georges Blanc, 2014 £42.90**  
The cherry, oak and blackberry scented 2009 Moulin-a- Vent Carquelin is medium to full bodied, silky textured. liquorice, blackberry, black cherries and roses are found in this structured wine.

### Languedoc-Roussillon

- 76 Duc De Chapelle, Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot, 2016 £27.35**  
Vibrant ruby-purple colour with almost jammy raspberry and sweet rose aromas.

### Bordeaux

- 77 Chateau Tour du Cauze, Saint Emilion, Grand Cru, 2012 £59.90**  
This most excellent wine exhibits very ripe fruit, aromas of redcurrant, blackberry and spicy notes combined with a black cherry and coffee finish.
- 78 Chateau La Croix Faerrandat, 2014 £39.95**  
Ripe and rounded with plum, bramble jelly and blackcurrant fruit. Medium to full bodied with soft tannins and a ling, fresh finish.
- 80 Chateau Gruaud Larose, St Julien, 2009 £195.50**  
An expressive nose here, with ripe dark cherry fruit. This has classic masculine Gruaud on the palate, with a very firm core of tannins running through a more supple near seamless presence of fruit. It has decent acidity too.

- 82      *Chateau Langoa Barton, Saint Julien, 1997*      **£189.50****  
 Mature ruby-garnet, some bricking at the rim, sweet, cedary nose, showing maturity. A cool leafy note, attractive red and dark berry fruit, lacking a little in concentration, though plenty of flavour, fresh, slightly piquant acidity, soft tannins at the finish.
- 85      *Chateau Talbot 4em Cru Classe, St Julien, 1995*      **£265.50****  
 On a regular flawless Talbot expressed very elegantly the complexity of its terroir, its round and firm tannins give it a sweetness that is found over the vintages. Its concentration allows a long ageing, although it is often tempting to young, to enjoy the fullness of its fruit and silky character. A beautiful classic Saint-Julien, deep and harmonious.
- 86      *Chateau Palmer, 1er Grand Cru, Margaux, 1983*      **£590.00****  
 Deep red/brown colour with a fading rim. Spicy, mineralic nose with some savoury herbal complexity. The palate is nicely evolved with firm, mineralic, earthy character.
- 87      *Chateau Latour, 1er Cru Classe, Pauillac, 1982*      **£2,250.00****  
 Dark in colour the nose on this wine at first has a new world quality with very ripe, dark fruit tinged with new oak. This changes quickly to show classic Pauillac notes of cedar, pencil shavings and underbrush. The palate is that of a large wine that is just a touch austere, tension between power and grace. The finish is long and has an iron and mineral quality.

## **Burgundy Red**

- 88      *Mercrey , " Cotes Chalonnaise " Agnes Dewe, 2016*      **£59.75****  
 This wine is elegant and delicate, with aromas of red fruits and flavours of ripe black fruits and cherries. The tannins are noticeable but well incorporated into the body of the wine.
- 89      *Cote de nuits Village, Louis Boillot & Fils,2008*      **£65.50****  
 Delicious and full bodied, concentrated black cherry and currant fruit layered with smoke, tobacco and wet earth. Full Complex finish.
- 92      *Charmes Chambertin Grand Cru, Domaine Geantet-Pansi'ot, 2000*      **£290.50****  
 A generous and distinctive wine, often superb. The colour is intense and bright. On the nose, the first impression that arises is that of cherry, then woody and fine spicy aromas appear, with an elegant hint of musk in some vintages. The flavours are extraordinary in their richness and harmony, neither too rough nor too heavy. The architecture of the wine is held up by fine and noble tannins, giving the body a silky texture (called "gras"). Acidity brings energy and liveliness to the whole, the after taste is a pure delight.

## Rhone Valley

- 95 Cotes du Rhone, Saint Cosme, 2016 £32.95**  
This 100 per cent syrah from the Gigondas area has deep colour and a spicy, earthy, graphite violet aroma and dark cherry, with little or no oak influence. Full, round palate with flesh and fruit sweetness, finishing with gently drying tannin.
- 97 Gigondas, La Bastide Saint Vincent, 2014 £54.95**  
Attractive nose of myrtle and hints of briary. The palate is savoury, with a flow of red berry fruit, and mild tannin.
- 98 Chateauneuf du Pape, Domaine des Sénéchaux, 2013 £75.95**  
A full-bodied, peppery, garrigue-dominated effort with loads of blackcurrant and cherry fruit. There is no evidence of new oak but it possesses plenty of glycerine along with low acidity. Complex!
- 100 Ermitage, Le Pavillon Chapoutier, 2001 £295.85**  
The 2001 Ermitage Le pavillon exhibits a saturated ruby/purple colour as well as a sweet nose of caphor,ink,crème de cassis and hints of liquorice and smoke.A great and intence wine.

## Italy

- 101 Vita Sangiovese - Merlot, 2016 £17.35**  
Soft and supple with red fruit flavours, a hint of violets, and a smooth finish.
- 102 Barolo, Enrico Serafino, 2017 £56.85**  
Centred around the village of the same name, the region of Barolo produces big, well-structured reds with a racy cut to the tannins. After a long maceration the wine is aged for three years, two in large oak barrels. Intensely elegant nose, with red fruit and spicy notes of liquorice and vanilla; the palate is austere with smooth tannins and a freshness to the finish.
- 103 Chianti Classico, Riserva Agostino Petri da Vicchiomaggio, 2015 £40.85**  
A richer Chianti with ripe concentrated flavours made from 90% Sangiovese, 5% Canaiolo and 5% Cabernet. The wine is matured in French oak barriques for six months and then in large oak barrels for a further nine months; this combination of modern and traditional ageing provides a balanced structure showing both fruit and notes of oak. Enticingly sweet, ripe fruit on the nose; the palate shows concentrated black cherries with rich, almost opulent tannins. A velvety wine with great complexity.

- 105 Chateau Musar, Gaston Hochar, 2009 £82.50**  
The Chateau Musar has a classic style, good depth of colour, red and black fruit on the nose. The cherry, cassis hint of chocolate follows through onto a palate with good power and concentration.

- 106 Don Jacobo Rioja Crianza, 2011 £28.00**  
A traditional red Rioja, full-bodied with a spicy, peppery taste. A perfect accompaniment to roast beef or lamb.
- 107 Rioja, Castillo Clavijo, Gran Reserva, 2010 £37.95**  
Smooth rounded and well balanced with savoury berry fruit and peppery spicy with hints of vanilla pod.

## South Africa

- 111 Pinotage, Cullinan View, 2018 £19.50**  
A typical South African plummy nose with a fruity cherry palate and a clean finish.
- 112 Laibach, Pinotage, Stellenbosch 2015 £33.90**  
Bright red, youthful Pinotage colour. Complex nose showing minty, black cherry and dried prune aromas. Hints of fresh leather and lavender tones leads into a medium weight palate. Good ripeness with generous tannins and well balanced classy oak.
- 113 Journeys End, Merlot. Stellenbosch 2011/2012 £37.95**  
Concentrated and lush on the palate, velvet soft tannins support the ripe, black fruit with a subtle chocolaty edge from the oak.
