PROJECT EXAMPLES

- Hampden Fields, Aylesbury: a major expansion of Aylesbury, including masterplanning and landscape architecture, and lead design expert witness.
- Land West of Warminster: site allocation in Local Plan and outline application for circa 1,500 dwellings and other uses as an extension to Warminster.
- Hullavington: Neighbourhood Plan promotion for village sites, with preparation of concept plans and initial capacity appraisal.
- Grange Fields, Stroud: a sensitive layout for a considered expansion of a constrained town set within the Cotswolds AONB.
- Mistley Village, Essex: consented scheme for expansion of a constrained village adjacent to an AONB, led by careful landscape assessment and design approach with photorealistic sketch layouts.
