Context of task:

Questions / Issues to address:

1. Who are the Nomads and where are they found?
2. Describe their life in the Horn of Africa
3. Find out how they get resources like water and fuel
4. Recognise some of the problems nomads face in the Horn of Africa
5. Understand how droughts come about and why is this an extra hard time for nomads
6. How the life of some nomads changing
