HGS's Local Governing Board shall comprise of at least 7 and no more than 11 Governors appointed as follows:

- up to 6 Governors appointed by the Schelwood Trust Board, having regard to any advice or nominations put forward by the Local Governing Board
- up to 2 Staff Governors appointed through such process as the LGB may determine
- up to 2 Parent Governors appointed by the Local Governing Board - the Headteacher of the Academy

Governors normally serve for 4 years

The quorum for a meeting of the Governing Body and for any vote on any matter at such a meeting, shall be one half (rounded up to a whole number) of the membership of the Governing Body in post.

CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR – Governing body elects them to serve for a period of one year.

QUORUM - For full meetings of the Governing Body 50% (rounded up to a whole number) of the complete membership of the governing body; this includes any governor vacancies. Three members form a quorum (to be present throughout the meeting) for all committees.

ATTENDANCE - If a Governor does not attend meetings of the Governing Body for a period of 6 months he/she ceases to be a Governor. Six months is calculated from the time of the first meeting missed. When an apology for absence is received the governing body must decide whether consent is given to the governor's absence. The decision must be minuted and sent to the governor concerned. It is not sufficient just to record the apology.
