Key achievements to date:	Areas for further improvement and baseline evidence of need:
<p>School is well resourced with equipment to enable all pupils to participate in physical activities.</p> <p>Staff training day with TAs to promote positive engagement PE has been organized with positive feedback from all staff</p> <p>Fitness and wellbeing project for class groups has helped to engage pupils, staff and parents in awareness raising of healthy lifestyles.</p> <p>Coaching programs have improved the range of sports pupils participate in – Primary access to climbing, judo, cricket.</p> <p>Some pupils have benefitted from Jittabugs - direct input from specials coaches has helped enhance staff knowledge skills and confidence to deliver these skills themselves</p> <p>Pupils are becoming more active during lunchtimes as training for Dinner staff on behavior support and use of SAFC staff have improved engagement levels.</p> <p>Cycling on and off site using adapted bicycles has continued to be a success.</p>	<p>Introduce daily mile to raise daily activity levels</p> <p>Staff review and reminders of learning – Training for Teachers around resources and using them in PE</p> <p>Continue to build on parental engagement through SAFC family liason project</p> <p>Widen the variety of sports pupils take part in to include Rugby skills, build on outdoor activities for primary pupils – staff supported to engage in outdoor activities within school</p> <p>Extend Jittabugs to other classes in the primary</p> <p>Additional resources to support lunchtime play.</p> <p>Training and support to extend and improve the skills of staff to deliver hydrotherapy in an exciting and engaging way</p> <p>Additional staff trained as lifeguards to support hydrotherapy within school</p>
