

Did you know that a carrot is actually the root of a plant? You don't often see the green leaves still on the carrots when you buy them from the supermarket.



These leaves are called 'fronds' and this is how you can grow them from a carrot top!

1. Carefully cut the top off a fresh carrot.
2. Place the carrot top on a small plate.
3. Pour a small amount of water on to the plate.
4. Place the plate on a window sill.
5. Check your carrot each day, if the water has dried out add some more.
6. Draw a picture of your carrot each day to make a diary of what happens.
7. Be patient! Enjoy experimenting!
