English

Ice Lolly... We are looking at a rhyme this week called 'Ice Lolly'. Can you read the rhyme with your grown up and create your own story map? 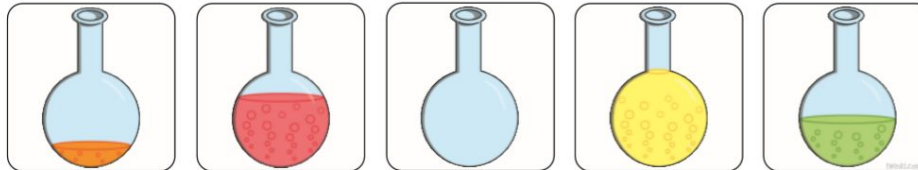
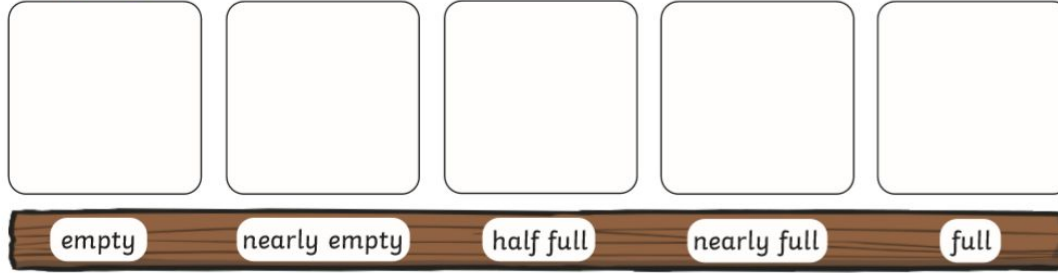
Capacity - Ordering Magic Potions

Can you make a half-full potion?

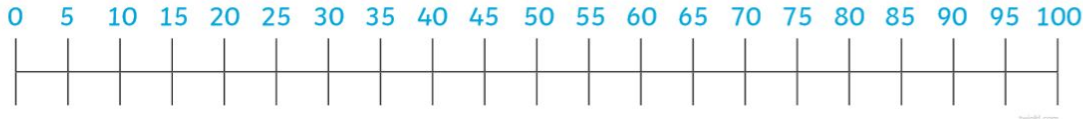
