<p><u>Five Minutes Peace by Jill Murphy</u></p> <p>You can listen to this story on Youtube or the children will know it from school. This story is about a mother who wants five minutes to relax.</p> <p>Write down 5 sentences with different places you could go to relax and what would you do?</p> <p>Bake a cake with your grown up?</p> <p>Draw your favourite things?</p> <p>Watch a film?</p>	<p><u>Write a letter to your new teacher.</u></p> <p>Can you write a letter to your new Year 1 teacher, telling them what you are good at, what you enjoy learning about in school, who you like to learn with etc.</p> <p>Can you draw a self portrait of yourself so your teacher knows what you look like.</p> <p>Why not take a picture of your letter and email it into school for the staff to look at.</p> <p>Email your name and picture of your letter to office@biddickhallinfants.co.uk</p>	<p>Counting on and back from a given number.</p> <p>Make a number line from 1-20</p>  <p>Your adult will give you a number to start counting on or back from eg. Count on from 5 : 5 6 7 8 9 ... Count back from 12: 12 11 10 9 8 ...</p> <p>Use the numberline to help and then challenge yourself to count without it.</p> <p>Can you say one more or one less than a given number.</p>	<p>Whole School - Choose a Book!</p> <p>You helped us to raise money on our sponsored walk around Biddick Hall and now we need your help to choose new books for our school.</p> <p>Visit the website https://www.lovereadng4kids.co.uk/ Find a book you would like to have in your class. <p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>New <u>two letter</u> spelling for <u>one</u> sound qu</p> <p>When writing this spelling (qu) your child should say the sound out loud when writing the two letters.</p> <p>Words to read and write:</p> <p>Quack, quest, quit, quick, quiz, quilt, squid, quell</p>	<p><u>Family:</u></p> <p>In the story of Five Minutes Peace, the family members are busy doing different jobs.</p> <p>Can you draw and write down sentences describing what jobs your family members do.</p> <p>E.G</p> <p>My little brother helps set the table at dinner time.</p> <p>My Mam drives to work in the car and works in a supermarket.</p> <p>I do my home learning with Dad and then I like to help cook in the kitchen.</p>	<p><u>Ordering Numbers</u></p> <p>Order a group of numbers from smallest to largest</p> <p>Eg</p> <p><u>4 7 3 2 1 10</u></p> <p>1 2 3 4 7 10</p> <p>Start with numbers 1-10 and move higher as you gain confidence.</p> <p>Remember you can use your number line from the previous activity.</p>	<p><u>Espresso Quiz</u></p> <p>Watch the key stage one news on Espresso. Go to Home, then in the search bar type 'news' then select key stage 1 and click on the magnifying glass. Then choose a news video to watch from the list.</p> <p>Then on the right click on Newsbites quiz - see if you can get all the questions right! Good luck!</p>

<p><u>Read something new!</u> Can you try and read something new?</p> <p>Listen to a story online, read a comic, read a recipe from a cook book etc.</p> <p>Look at how it is different to a story book with characters etc.</p>	<p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Read each sentence out loud to your child fully. -</p> <p>The queen ran quick when she heard the duck quack.</p> <p>Ask your child to write each word as you say it again. Say one at a time for your child to write. Remind them to use finger spaces, a capital letter and a full stop.</p>	<p><u>Missing Numbers</u></p> <p>Ask your adult to make you a numberline similar to one we used earlier but to leave some blanks. Can you fill in the missing numbers?</p>	<p><u>Summer picture</u></p> <p>Can you draw a picture of things you enjoy doing in the Summer. Remember to label your picture.</p> <p>Think about visiting the beach and making sand castles, playing in the garden, going on a flower walk and looking at different varieties.</p>
