<p>The school will do its best to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection; ● Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can; ● Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child’s well-being, mental health and academic needs; ● Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19; ● Inform you if staff or children in your child’s ‘bubble’ show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative; ● Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlines in this agreement; ● Communicate between home and school through, newsletters, email and the school website 	<p>Parent/Carer.....</p> <p>To help my child at school, I know and understand that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via Studybugs or telephone; ● If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will arrange for my child to leave school immediately; ● I will encourage my child to walk or cycle to school ● If I need to drop my child off and or pick them up, I will not turn into the school site. I will use Bidford Road as a drop off point. I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules ● When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child; ● My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school; ● I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules ● My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene – eg regular hand washing/use of hand sanitiser; ● I will not be allowed into the school without a pre arranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email; ● I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an ‘as safe as possible’ environment during this pandemic; ● I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home; ● I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details. ● If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe. 	<p>Student’s Name.....</p> <p>I will do my best to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and around the school site; ● Stay in my ‘bubble’ all day; ● Tell an adult if I feel unwell; ● Have sufficient equipment to complete my day at school and have responsibility for my own possessions; ● Not mix with any other children from other year groups within the school; ● Only enter and exit the school site from the designated gate/entry point; ● Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it); ● Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser; ● Behave well and with respect to others, at all times to maintain the safety of myself and everyone; ● Follow these expectations and know that if I don’t, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
