

An exploration of what our purpose as humans is through an introduction to philosophy and ethics, including an introduction to Situation Ethics, Utilitarianism and the Categorical Imperative.

An investigation of whether religion causes more peace or conflict with a focus on Sikh, Christian and Muslim beliefs about conflict;
