An individual student is self-isolating.	<p>CURRENT PRACTICE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PMs send text advising students how to access Google Meet and how to access the two week home learning programme • PMs send home hard of the two week home learning programme to students who do not have access to a computer/laptop • Teachers are provided with a list of self-isolating students in the bulletin each day • Wherever possible, teachers share classroom lessons using Google Meet. • Teachers set homework on SMHW in the usual way. <p>NEXT STEPS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Digital student leaders record lesson details and upload classwork onto Google Classroom to share with quarantining students.
A whole class/ bubble are self-isolating but other classes are in school	<p>CURRENT PRACTICE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teachers are provided with a list of self-isolating classes and students in the bulletin each day • Self-isolating classes follow the normal timetable. • In-school classes follow the normal timetable • Wherever possible, teachers deliver lessons to the self-isolating class using Google Meet • If teachers are unable to deliver a lesson using Google Meet, teachers will set work will be set on Google Classroom • Teachers set homework on SMHW in the usual way. • PMs will send work home in hard copy where students do not have access to a computer/ laptop. <p>NEXT STEPS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Development of online pedagogy e.g. instructions, explanations, assessment, differentiation, engagement
