



Using Google Classroom at Home

Navigate to the school website - <http://www.stjosephsjarrow.co.uk/>



Login using your child's username and password




The username is usually the child's first name and the first letter of their surname
Eg Thomas Brown would be thomasb


The username is not case-sensitive, the password is.

Your child's username and password have been sent home.


Early Years children have had their email addresses sent home too.




Your child's class name will appear. Click join.

You will see something similar to this -



Stream will be in blue, this is where you will find messages from the class teacher. Students can use this to ask questions.

If you click on classwork, it will change to blue -



This is where you will see any work that has been set. It will also give instructions on sharing work with the class teacher.

If you are using the Classroom app you will need to sign in using your child's email address as it will ask for the gmail account. You must sign in with your child's gmail account to access their work.

The email address is the same as the username for the website and @stjosephsjarrow.co.uk

Eg. username jenniferm2 - email address would be jenniferm2@stjosephsjarrow.co.uk

Please note that if you have a gmail account and you are logged into your account, **you must log out** before logging into your child's account. If you don't there will be a clash with the gmail accounts.

There is a way around this (on some device), but it is best practice to log out of your account when not using it.
