


TASK 6: TUMBLES AND GRUMBLES QUIZ

- Cut out all of the 9's and colour them in. Make sure you have three 9's for each team or player.
- There are 2 teams; TEAM TUMBLES and TEAM GRUMBLES.
- One person should be the Quiz Master and ask the questions (you can be a player and a quiz master).
- Once the question is read out, if you know the answer shout your team name; either "TUMBLES" or "GRUMBLES".
- Whoever shouts first gets to answer the question. If they get it right they win a 9.
- If they don't get it right they don't win anything for that question.
- The first team or player to get three 9's wins!
