Don't

DON'T just choose words located on or around the computer

DON'T leave yourself logged in to any computers

Do

DO choose something you can definitely remember

DO use the first letters of a phrase or song (E.g. 'Oops I Did it Again' would be 'oidia')

DO use real words with extra letters (e.g. hhappy)

DO add words together with numbers in the middle (e.g. fun4you)

DO keep an eye out for people looking over your shoulder
