

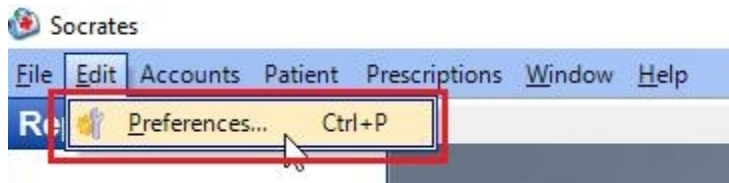

PCRS Checker

A PCRS Certificate is now required where you want to check GMS / DVC Card validity in Patient Demographics and for Chronic Disease Management (CDM Protocol).

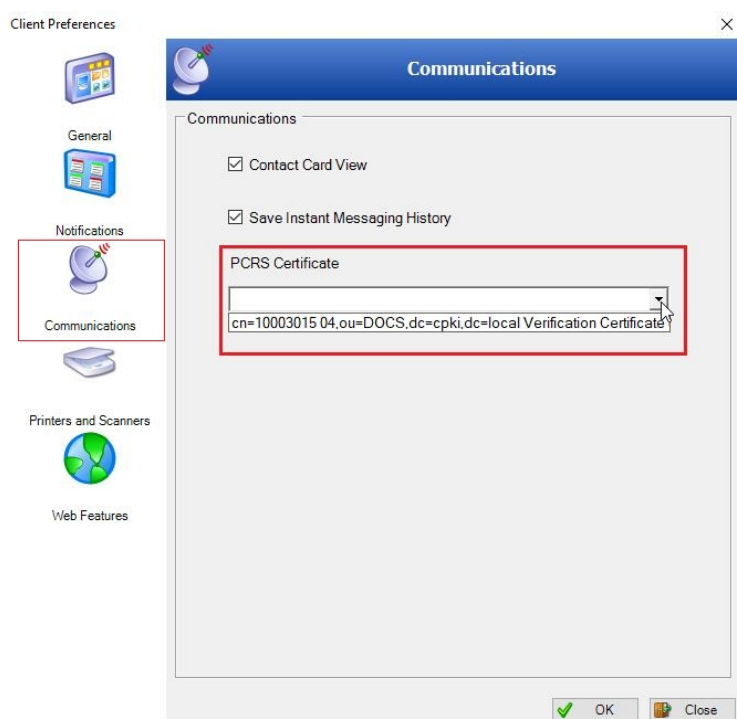
- Ensure you have a valid PCRS Certificate on your machine. If you require a PCRS Certificate please contact PCRS.
- Once you have a valid PCRS Certificate on your machine, you need to select the Certificate in Edit > Preferences.

Select Edit > Preferences.



Select Communication.

Select the PCR Certificate from the dropdown list and click **OK**. [If no certificate is showing in the PCRS Certificate dropdown list please check you have a valid PCRS Certificate installed. Please contact PCRS if you need a new PCRS Certificate.]



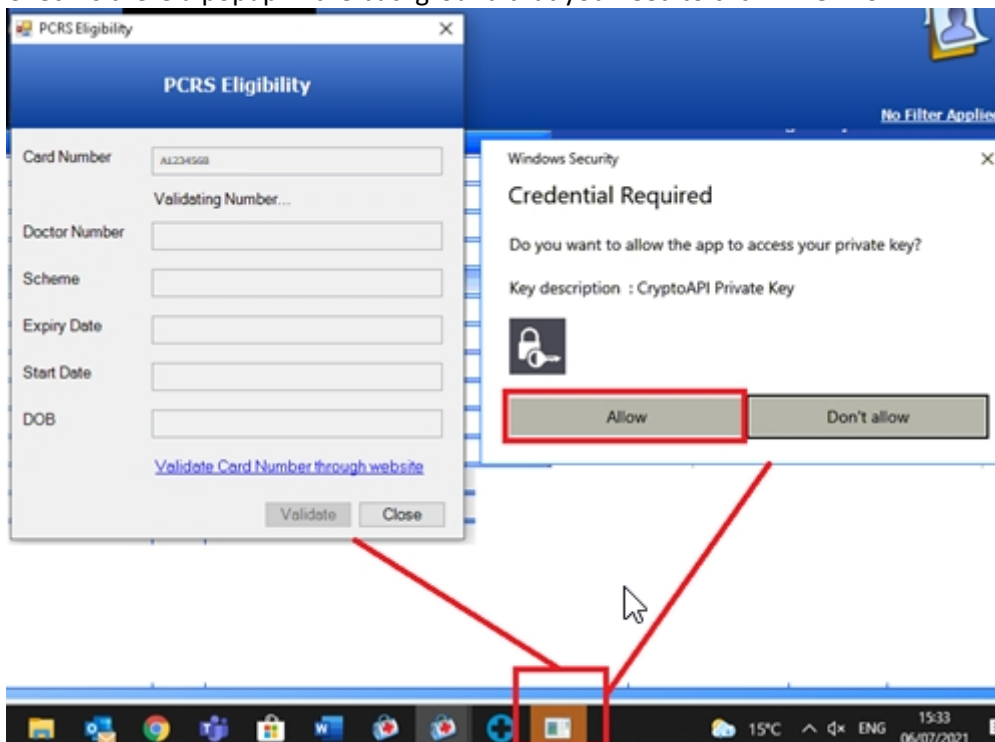
Troubleshooting

If you do not have a valid PCRS Cert selected in Edit > preferences, you will receive this error message when trying to use the PCRS Checker.



If you have a valid PCRS Certificate and the PCRS Checker is still not working for you please check the following:

- Check is there a popup in the background that you need to click ALLOW on.



- Click **Patient GMS No** link in Patient Registration then click the **'Validate Card number through website'** link on the link in Patient Personal Details and confirm it loads correctly. If you receive a pop up message (can be hidden in the background) then you will need to click ALLOW.
